HSK 2 (Beginner Level)

At this level learn how to describe people, things, situations, etc. Learn grammar and vocabulary to the next level

- Master pinyin and the mandarin phonetic system
- Develop a speaking vocabulary of 200 of the most commonly used words.
- Be able to write 150 Chinese characters
- Exchange everyday greetings
- Ask and respond to simple questions including dates, age, nationality, locations, and weather.
- Develop knowledge of 50 basic grammar points.
- Understand simple Chinese etiquette and customs

HSK 3 (Pre-Intermediate Level)

Get familiar with talking about stories, sharing ideas, conversation, and more. Learn about prepositions with verbs, degrees of adjectives, time structure, etc

- Develop a speaking and listening vocabulary of approximately 600 words.
- Understand a passage of about 300 words with 80% comprehension.
- Talk about hobbies, habits, experiences, travel, etc,
- Use the future, present, and past tenses (speaking)
- Read an article of about 400 words with 75% comprehension.
- Write a composition of about 180 words with reasonable accuracy (writing)
- Understand basic Chinese etiquette
- Customs related to the course content (culture)

HSK 4 (Intermediate Level)

<u>Learn about clauses, negative sentences, participle, etc along with discussions on the world economy, childhood problems, and more</u>

- Develop a speaking and listening vocabulary of approximately 1000 words (vocabulary)
- Understand a passage of about 500 words with 80% comprehension (listening)
- Learning how to do a presentation (speaking)
- Read articles of about 800 words with 85% comprehension (reading)
- Understand more Chinese etiquette and customs related to the course content (culture)

HSK 5 (Advanced Level)

At this level, learn to read and discuss newspapers, magazines, Mandarin literature, and cultural issues. Learn advanced grammar and its usage

- Develop a vocabulary of approximately 2000 words
- Conduct in-depth topic discussions
- Comprehend and write Chinese articles
- Understand more Chinese social issues and philosophy of life related to the course content
